

To Get Around Honolulu:

**From East-West Center:** The most convenient way to use ground transportation is to take a taxi. You must call for taxi service. Be sure to inform the taxi dispatcher of your exact location. If you are at East-West Center, specify the building (Lincoln Hall or Burns Hall, etc.). You will also need to inform the dispatcher of your destination. Generally, after making the call, a taxi will come in about 10 minutes. You can ask the dispatcher how long it will take for the driver to pick you up.

**To East-West Center:** If you are in Waikiki, you can find taxi cabs in queue at many hotels or you may call for service.

Cost of taxi fare from East-West Center to Waikiki is about \$15-\$20.

# Relevant bus stops and routes

## Bus Fare Information

Please note that you must have exact change when boarding the bus. The driver does not carry any bills or coins.

### Adult Fare & Passes

“Adult” means any person over the age of 17 who does not qualify as a “Youth.”

One-way fare: \$2.75

1-Day Pass: \$5.50

Ask your bus operator for the 1-Day Pass before placing your money in the farebox.

Valid 12:00 a.m. - 2: 59 a.m. the next day, for up to 27 hours of unlimited rides.




Each **bus stop sign** lists the **route numbers** that pick up and drop off passengers at that particular stop. Also look for the **Information hotline number** listed on the signs.

**Please note the time the final evening bus leaves your stop and plan your trips accordingly.**

## Bus Route Destinations


**A Express route:**

Liliha


**#18 route:**

**NOTE:** The **A Express** will make a **U-turn** on University Avenue before heading south to your destination.




The **A Express route** goes to **Downtown/Chinatown** and near **Ala Moana Shopping Center**.

The bus stop for the **#6 route** is on **University Avenue and Dole Street**, across from the campus near the Japanese restaurant **Tsukuneya**.



The **#6 route** goes to **Ala Moana Shopping Center**.

The bus stop for the #18 route is on **Dole Street**, near the **corner of East-West Road**.



The #18 turns into the #24 route (stay on the bus) and goes to Diamond Head. It also goes to Ala Moana Shopping Center.

A bus stop for the #13 route is also located on **Dole Street**, near the **corner of East-West Road**.



There is also a bus stop for the #13 route located on **East-West Road**, across from **Kennedy Theatre**.

The #13 departs from the **University of Hawaii** and goes via **Kapahulu** to **Waikiki**, past **City Hall**, and on to the **Liliha** area.
